Tea, Coffee etc will be served after both Solemn Masses: 9:15 and 11:15. We very much hope you can stay.

Today at S Mary's: welcome to those who are having their wedding banns read. We hold them in our hearts and prayers.

Today is Rosary Sunday: the readings at both Solemn Masses will be from the sheet, but the propers will be particular to the feast. At S Mary's we will use the Extraordinary Rite this week, as a number of people have considerable affection for it. The Asperges will be used as the Penitential rite in both churches also.

Masses this week: are back to the normal times. Thursday last week I was away so missed the feast of S Wenceslaus – I shall therefore be keeping the Octave of S Wenceslaus on Thursday of this week.

Wednesday 4th October S Francis Hammerfield (Glenview Road, Hemel Hempstead HP1 1TD) St Francis Patronal Festival. Again, I am sure Fr Weizmann (the Curate of Boxmoor) would be most happy to see people at 8:00pm that day. S Francis is a delightful little church, and well worth a visit for their festival.
